Position Qualifications

- Must be at least eighteen (18) years of age
- O Have at least six (6) months of qualifying child care experience
- Must have a Satisfactory Criminal Records Check prior to hire
- O Possess at least one of the following sets of minimum academic requirements and qualifying childcare experience at the time of employment: Child Development Associate (CDA) or Child Development and Related Care Diploma from a vocational institute, Technical Certificate of Credit (TCC) in Early Childhood Development, Paraprofessional Certificate, Twenty-five (25) quarter hours or fifteen (15) semester hours from an accredited College or University in Early Childhood Education or Child Development or in another field of study.
- Must be great with children and have good classroom management skills
